


# Malawi epidemiology and control profile




### Population density and distribution




### Identified mosquito species by district


### Mass net distribution campaigns 2014-8



### Routine LLIN distribution by district 2015-7




### Mass LLIN distribution by district 2015-7



### Percent of population under insecticide treated nets (ITNs)




### Proportion of households with at least 1 ITN for every 2 persons
